Special Olympics AZ and the History of the AZPHC's Volunteering Involvement...by Mike McMahon

In the early 1990's Special Olympics had County Track and Field Games at Phoenix College in the heart of Phoenix, Arizona. The Track and Field events allowed competition for all ages in running, throwing and jumping events. We chose the Arizona Special Olympics as both a target for donations and an activity to volunteer with. The Club chose the 100 meter races to run as their event. Club members started the race, lined up athletes in their lanes and time blocks, cheered and hugged the finishers. They also recorded finishing times and took athletes to receive their earned medals. The Club's response was an immediate affection to a group that showed courage, heart and joy in their events.

In the early 2000's the club chose the shotput or as they affectionately called "Tossing Cannonballs". Throughout a period of time the event was moved to Washington High School Track, where they continued to assist in the Shotput event, and the event changed from an all-day event to just a half day of athletes

On May 7, 2022 The AZPHC reacquainted a relationship with Special Olympics at the State level, which is now being held at Kellis High School in Peoria and it includes athletes of all ages throughout a day's worth of events. The club selected to help with the Running Long Jump measuring jumping distances, officiating good or default attempts, raking the (beach) sand, recording distances and again demonstrated spirited support by cheering for the athletes. There were not as many athletes as usual, about half, and there was a slower pace because of it. The athletes again showed us their competitive nature with individual character and joy.

The response by the Parrot Heads was an overwhelming "YES" to continuing to help with more events in the future. We look forward to next year's event and seeing more and more athletes return for such a fun


