Spring Training with the Cubbies...by Paula



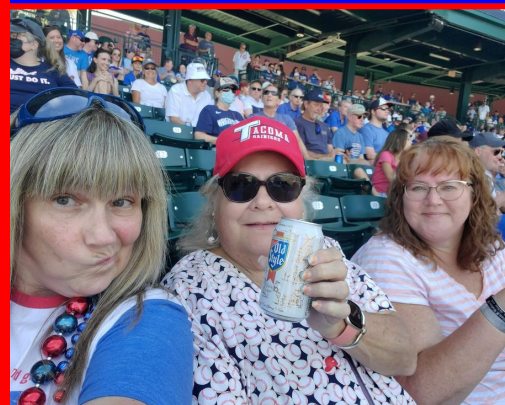

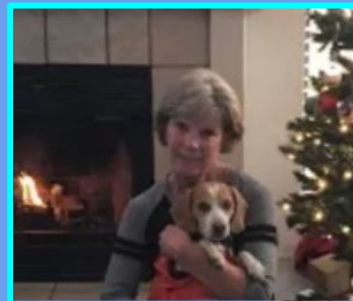

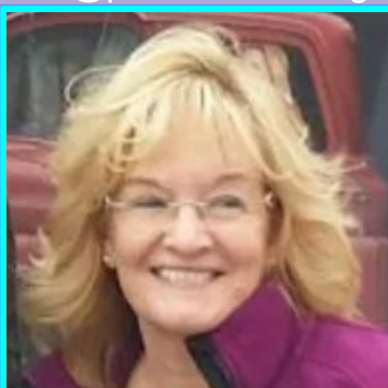
